<p>Option 2 - Space Comic Create a comic strip about space. Perhaps you could tell the story of an astronaut or an alien as they travel the Solar System! You will need to include pictures and text to create your mini comic.</p>	<p>Think carefully about how you are going to present your information - a PowerPoint, a booklet, a quiz (make sure you include the answers!) etc</p>	<p>Option 2 In Woking outside The Big Apple there are a few sculptures based on the Martians in The War of the Worlds - use these as inspiration to create your own Martian sculpture.</p>
