Who can become a Link Parent? *Any parent can volunteer to be a Link Parent by completing the form below.*

Can I be a Link Parent with someone else? *Yes! More than one parent can agree to volunteer to share the role.*

How will I communicate with the parents in my child's class? *Once we have the name and contact details of the Link Parent for a class, we will send these out to the other parents in the class so that they can contact the Link Parent and provide their contact details if they wish to do so. The Link Parent will then be able to contact parents directly in a number of ways that works for them, e.g. an email group, Facebook page or Whatsapp group.*

How will I communicate with the class teacher? *The Link Parent will be able to communicate with the class teacher via the year group email address in The Hermitage School and the office in The Oaktree School.*

Who do I liaise with and what does the role involve? *Mainly, the role involves liaising with the class teacher and communicating any useful information to the other parents in the class. The aim is to reach as many parents as possible to ensure information is shared. Occasionally, the class teacher may ask you to help recruit volunteers for school trips or big events. You will also be invited to attend meetings once a half term with a member of the Senior Leadership Team and the other link parents to share ideas and information.*
