The entire year group did themselves proud and showed great bounce-back-ability.

We cannot forget our children in Year 2, who have also completed SATs this month, albeit unknowingly. They have remained positive and resilient, rising to every challenge they have faced this half term.








Year 2








Year 4

Forest School



Hello! I am Mrs Hallums, the Forest School Leader at The Hermitage.

I have three children, who all attended The Oaktree and Hermitage schools. They are now studying at The Winston Churchill School and at Farnborough 6th Form College. Outside of work I am usually found in the kitchen, garden or on the allotment that I share with Mrs Ditton – always with music on in the background!

This is my sixth year working at The Hermitage School, where I have spent most of my time working with the children in The Orchard Centre. I have been teaching at Forest School for the past year and am a qualifed Forest School practitioner.

Each half term I take small groups of children, from all year groups, out to our woodland area at the far end of our school field. The children delight in discovering nature and learn how to look after our natural environment. We learn how to safely use tools, such as hand drills and knives, to create useful tools such as pegs for holding down shelters as well as jewellery, toys and games. A big favourite of the children is learning how to build and light fires safely and cooking popcorn, making smores and drinking hot chocolate.

There is, however, much more to Forest School and, through playing and learning new practical skills, the children develop social skills, build confidence and learn how our school values can be put into practice. I love to see the children learn and grow and all whilst getting dirty and having a lot of fun!
