



The children have showed such enthusiasm learning phonics' and used this knowledge in their early writing. Its lovely to see so many of the children attempting to write and form the letters correctly

We have also been learning about different animal parts in Science, thinking about the different animal groups and the features of those animals.





#### Year 3

This term, Year 3 are learning all about how to grow plants in Science. They will be going on their school trip to Wisely Gardens in a week, which will be the perfect opportunity to see their learning in action. In Art, they have been creating mixed media art work with a plant theme. They explored different ways of printing (tile printing and leaf printing) and made a collages background. To finish it off, they backed their own work and arranged it in a nature-inspired way for the final photograph. Aren't they beautiful!















#### Year 5

Last half term Year 5 enjoyed their topic on rivers. In Art we made river dioramas out of shoe boxes and paper mache to show the different features of a river. It was great fun but very messy!


